In addition to using vermicompost, brewing tea and using it as a soil drench or foliar spray has shown to be very beneficial. The bacterial and fungal population in quality compost is about 1 billion per teaspoon. In actively aerated vermicompost tea (AACT), this population can grow exponentially.

The National Organic Standards Board (NOSB) convened two task forces that delivered comprehensive reports to the NOSB on compost (2002) and compost tea (2004). The NOSB then made a final recommendation on compost, compost tea, processed manure, and vermicompost in November 2006.

There is another way to make compost tea. This method simply requires you to steep vermicompost in a container of water overnight. One way to do this is to simply add about 1/4 cup of vermicompost or vermicastings to a gallon of water, then strain the vermicompost by pouring the mixture through a fine sieve or filter.

How to Make Vermicompost Tea - The Spruce

1 to 6 ounces (30 to 200 mL) liquid, filtered plant extract material (for example, yucca extracts, nettle soup, dandelion wine, comfrey tea), proteins, fruit juices, fruit pulp, fish emulsion. Add nothing with a preservative or antibiotic in it. Aerate frequently each day for up to a week.

Using the same water within the same temperature range, with: 4% compost/vermicompost, 0.75% black strap molasses, 0.25% kelp meal and 0.063% fish hydrolysate, the DO2 is maintained at 8.8 to 9.8 PPM up to a 48 hour brew time. Please note that these are maximum amounts of compost inputs and not recommended for people brewing without microscopes.
