Facial harmony is also achieved with orthognathic surgery. When the jaws are moved forward or backwards, up or down, or rotated, the facial soft tissue in the chin, cheeks, lips and tip of the nose move accordingly.

ORTHOGNATHIC MAXILLARY SURGERY. The maxillary surgery is performed to place the jaw in the correct position so that facial harmony can be achieved and, most importantly, a recovery of the functionality of this bone, key for chewing, breathing and speaking. This procedure is performed to correct several facial deformities, such as mandibular prognathism, or Class 3, open bite or gingival smile.

With the advent of orthognathic procedures, the search for facial balance has increased, as well as the need to study aesthetically pleasant faces, both for those presenting with dentofacial deformities to be corrected and those who have already undergone surgery, aiming at reestablishing the harmonious facial characteristics. 5 Thus, a subjective facial analysis must be accomplished, which represents the key to the diagnosis, following the clinical dental exam. 6

Criteria for Orthognathic Surgery

Evaluation of the facial harmony values indicated that most Turkish mean harmony values for intramandibular and interjaw relationships, orbits to jaws, and the total face were within the range of harmony standards of Arnett et al.. All soft tissue thicknesses of Turkish males were statistically greater than those of females.

Their use to restore facial harmony after accidental trauma, radiotherapy, or cancer surgery 10,15 has achieved a consensus. 17,18 They also are used in the correction of congenital deformities and in esthetic contouring surgery. 6, 19, 20, 21 However, the use of HDPE implants to refine the outcome of orthognathic surgery has been scarcely described in the literature. 9,22

Four hundred fifty consecutive cleft patients with complete data and who had been treated from 1969 to 2007, were reviewed. In unilateral cleft patients, 30% required orthognathic surgery. In bilateral cleft patients, 40% underwent orthognathic surgery to achieve facial balance and harmony after completion of growth.
