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AMANA Maharshi attributed unique value to this lucid exposition of Supreme Truth, the Ribhu Gita, and often referred to it in his talks with devotees and seekers. He is reported to have said that if one repeatedly read Chapter 26 [Heart] of the Ribhu Gita one could pass spontaneously into samadhi, or the natural state of Self-realisation.

The Ribhu Gita was translated into Tamil verse by a Brahmin Vedic scholar of high repute, by name Bikshu Sastri who was also an accomplished scholar in Tamil.
