The data were analyzed using the content analysis approach. The study identified that the lexical errors in the students' writing were due to homophone problems and semantic lexical errors. The grammatical errors identified were agreement errors, tense errors, singular-plural (number) errors, prepositional errors, and article errors.

The error frequencies in table 4 seem to suggest that the prepositions at, in and of cause particular problems for learners. Indeed, these three prepositions together account for almost 60% of all preposition errors observed in the translation tasks.
