We have a busy cardiac surgery service here and without any cardiac anesthesia fellows we are involved in any and all of the cases - from a simple 2 vessel CABG to an LVAD placement to a heart transplant. Our exposure to cardiac anesthesia starts as early as our CA-1 year for those residents in the categorical track and early in the CA-2 year for those in the advanced track.
