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## Electrode Selection Guide

Selection of current for E6010 Electrode. The correct welding amperage (current) setting mainly depends on the electrode diameter used. For example, a 1/8-inch E6010 rod runs well from 70 to 130 ampere, while a 3/16 inch E6010 rod welds at currents up to 225 amperes. These rod shall be used with DCEP type (electrode positive) welding polarity.

Power-source selection: When selecting a power source for GMAW of aluminum, first consider the method of transfer -spray-arc or pulse. Constant-current (cc) and constant-voltage (cv) machines can be used for spray-arc welding. Spray-arc takes a tiny stream of molten metal and sprays it across the arc from the electrode wire to the base material.

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
