Presentation dimension vs screen resolution. By default, the size of the new presentation in PowerPoint, is currently a widescreen type presentation, 13.333 inch by 7.5 inch. Mostly you will have 96 dots per inch (dpi) on your screen settings, so this means that a default PowerPoint presentation has a resolution of 1280 by 720 pixels.

The optimal resolution for images on screen is 72 DPI. Increasing the DPI won't make the image look any better, it'll just make the file larger, which will probably ...

Depending on your eyesight, you may find the default blinking cursor in Windows 10 too small or thin and difficult to easily find on the screen of your computer. As you must have noticed, this problem becomes more pronounced if the LCD monitor is set to high resolution.

As you move the arrow to the left, the resolution decreases. This means that fewer pixels will be viewable on the screen, and the text and images will be larger as a result. On most monitors, "800 by 600 pixels" will be the lowest resolution, resulting in the largest print.
