Some US\$35 billion of IMF financial support was provided for adjustment and reform programs in Indonesia, Korea, and Thailand, with the assistance for Indonesia being augmented further in 1998-99. Some US\$85 billion of financing was committed from other multilateral and bilateral sources, although not all of this financing actually materialized.

The type of program, the amount of financial support, and the program's conditions are country-specific.
