Randomize scheduled scans. Scheduled scans run in addition to real-time protection and scanning,. The start time of the scan itself is still based on the scheduled scan policy (ScheduleDay, ScheduleTime, and ScheduleQuickScanTime).Randomization will cause Microsoft Defender Antivirus to start a scan on each machine within a 4-hour window from the time set for the scheduled scan.

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
