Following one of the fundamental principles of MLA style, writers citing legal works should document the version of the work they consult—not the canonical version of the law, as in legal style.

The MLA style discourages the use of italics in academic prose to emphasize or point, because they are unnecessary—most often, the unadorned words do the job without typographic assistance. Writing author names in MLA. Published on March 27, 2019 by Courtney Gahan. Revised on July 12, 2021 by Shona McCombes. In MLA style, up to two authors are included in a citation.For sources with more than two authors, the citation is shortened with "et al." In the Works Cited list, the first author's name is inverted (surname followed by first name).

Author Names in MLA | Citing One or Multiple Authors
If writing about one play, use the author's last name in the parenthetical citation. However, if writing a paper that refers to more than one work, use the play's title. For example: If one were to write a paper on Othello in which he or she quoted only that play, Shakespeare would be used in the citation. • (Shakespeare 3.3.165-171)

APA reference list vs MLA Works Cited list. In both APA and MLA style, you list full details of all cited sources on a separate page at the end of your paper. In APA this is usually called the reference list; in MLA it is called the Works Cited. The formatting of source entries is different in each style.

Including images as figures. If you include an image directly in your paper, it should be labeled "Fig." (short for "Figure"), given a number, and presented in the MLA figure format.. Directly below the image, place a centered caption starting with the figure label and number (e.g. "Fig. 2"), then a period.

When citing a research paper in MLA style, include references within two sections: The quotes used within the essay, The Works Cited page at the end; Quotes.
