Osteoarthritis (OA) is the most common form of arthritis, affecting nearly 30 million nationwide. OA is a degenerative joint disease often described as “wear and tear” arthritis. A common complaint from patients is pain in the weight-bearing joints such as the hips, knees and spine as well as involvement in the finger joints.

Unfortunately, little research has focused on the nursing care of patients with arthritis. The work so far has focused on outcomes from rheumatology nursing clinics (Hill et al, 2003; Hill et al, 2002), and these studies demonstrate benefit to patients with rheumatoid arthritis and osteoarthritis.

The management of osteoarthritis and rheumatoid arthritis ...

Osteoarthritis (OA) also known as degenerative joint disease (DJD) or osteoarthrosis is the most common kind of arthritis associated with progressive degeneration of articular cartilage in synovial joints. Usually, weight-bearing joints and the spine are affected. Although the disease occurs most often in older adults, osteoarthritis is not part of the normal aging process.
