Predicting Act Score From Explore

That would be too simple. Instead, the test makers add up all of your correct answers to get what they call a “raw” score. That score is put through what they call a scoring formula to get your “scaled” score. ACT scaled scores range from 1 to 36. Nearly half of all test takers score within a much narrower range: 17 to 23.

If you use an SAT score to estimate your ACT score, the prediction could be off by up to 4 points. As an example, I got a 1420 on my SAT. Using this score and the conversion table, I found out my ACT score prediction would be 31, but I got a 34, 3 points more than the estimate.

Explore was also a version of the ACT, but shorter and designed to predict the future success of middle school students. The Plan was scored between 1-32, whereas the ACT is scored between 1-36. It predicted an ACT score between 1 and 5 points higher than the Plan score. Table 1.

Is ACT Aspire An Accurate Predictor of Your Real ACT Score?

The ACT Aspire is scored on a scale from 400 to 470 for each subject, with 470 being a top score. As you can see, the scale is very different between the two exams, which may make it more difficult to interpret how your ACT Aspire score will translate to the ACT.

Scores Mean? Your scores are between 1 (the lowest score you can receive) and 35 (the highest score you can receive). PreACT takes the number of questions you got right on each test and translates it into a number between 1 and 35 (called a “scale score”). Just like grades, your scores tell you how well you did on each test.

One caveat: My son's ACT score is quite a bit higher than what would be predicted from his fifth-grade scores. He has had a pretty rigorous curriculum, and I do think that can make a difference. So use this as a very rough guide, and don't assume that a fifth-grader who doesn't have an "Ivy League" score in fifth grade won't be much improved by 12th.

The tables in Table Set 5 show the accuracy of the estimated MAP cut scores in predicting whether students met or exceeded the corresponding college readiness benchmark for the study sample. In general, the estimated MAP cut scores accurately predicted whether or not students would meet the EXPLORE, PLAN, and ACT benchmarks with 75-90% accuracy.

The curves of over 35 released ACT exams (from The Red Book, Q&A Service, and yearly booklets) have been thoroughly analyzed to bring you the most accurate prediction of your scores. For any given raw score, the entire range of scaled scores across all curves are computed along with the percentage of times each one has shown up in the past.

Their findings confirmed earlier research that showed \high school GPAs are better predictors of college graduation than SAT and ACT scores. After controlling for student backgrounds and college characteristics, the researchers found that the chance of graduating from college ranges from 20 percent for students with high school GPAs under 1.5 to approximately 80 percent for students with GPAs of 3.75 or higher.

High school GPA vs ACT scores: Which predicts college ...

Similar to other linking studies, the ACT College Readiness Benchmark study correlates student RIT scores with future scores on a particular test (in this case, the ACT). While most linking studies correlate a RIT score to another test that the student will take later in the same year, this linking study correlates the student’s RIT score to the ACT test when they take it later in high school.

Because the ACT score contributes little to the prediction, there is a similar amount of school-level variance in the combined model (0.622) as the model that includes HSGPA alone (0.603, from Table 3). ACT scores used at the individual student level do not reduce the variability by high school in predicting who will graduate college.
