In 1892 newspaper publisher Joseph Pulitzer offered Columbia University's president Seth Low \$2 million to set up the world's first school of journalism. However, the university initially turned down the money, and on September 8, 1908 the first actual journalism school opened its doors at the University of Missouri, which, coincidentally, is located in Columbia, MO.
