The line opened in 1932 and was originally called the Fleet Line, but the name was changed to Jubilee two years after the Queen's Silver Jubilee, in 1979. It was successfully extended during the 1990s eastwards from Green Park to where it terminates in Stratford, but further extensions that were planned never actually came to light.
